At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to properly display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Anglers are required to have a valid Wisconsin fishing license/ permit, if applicable by law.
Fish LimitsLargemouth, smallmouth & spotted Bass14" inch minimumAnglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five(5) fish per team unless otherwise requiredby law or tournament officials.Fish presented which fails to measure theofficial length limits shall accrue penaltiesat the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ouncededuction will be made for each fishpresented that is determined to benon-releasable.
