Absolutely NO boats or trailers at meeting.

Date: Friday, September 6, 2024

Registration Times:

4:30 p.m. – Registration Opens 5:30 p.m. – Registration Closes and Mandatory rules briefing begins.

All anglers must be off the water by 3:30 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Fish Limits

Largemouth and smallmouth Bass 12" inches and over.

Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per person unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.

Overall Payback in cash and prizes is more than 100%!

- 75% payback to 20% of the field for both boaters and coangler
- 10% to State Federations
- 15% to Federation Championship

Launch/Weigh-In

Location:

Carlos State Park Beach, Public Access Launch fee required at Lake Carlos State Park.

Parking will be assigned at Friday night meeting by boat number per DNR rules.

Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.

Weigh-in starts at 3:00 p.m. All boats must clean, drain and dry when leaving waters.

Required Items and Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of each participant to have ALL required state and federal safety equipment on board as well as, ALL permits' licenses, passes or stamps, etc. required.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to properly display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

A valid Minnesota fishing license is required. All participants MUST cooperate with AIS inspectors at public launch locations.

Boundaries

Anglers cannot go under the bridges to Lake Jessie, Lake Cowdrey and Lake Alvin.

Tournament waters are OFF limits Monday, and Tuesday, prior to the event. Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are practice days. Saturday and Sunday are competition days (Read the rules)

Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
